Buying the train ticket. This is not too bad. I had seen this before in China 30 years ago with situation at least 10 times worse than this.





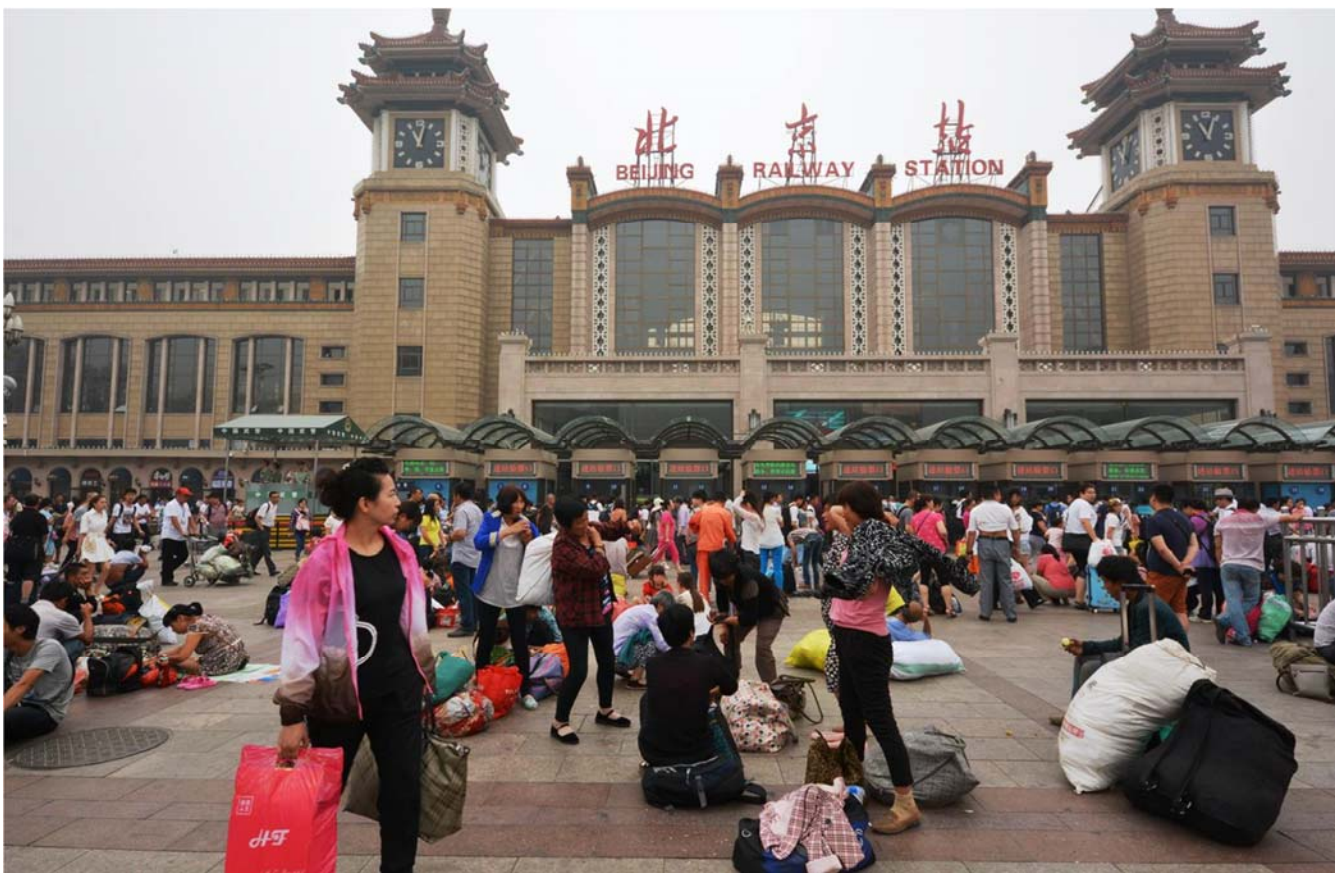

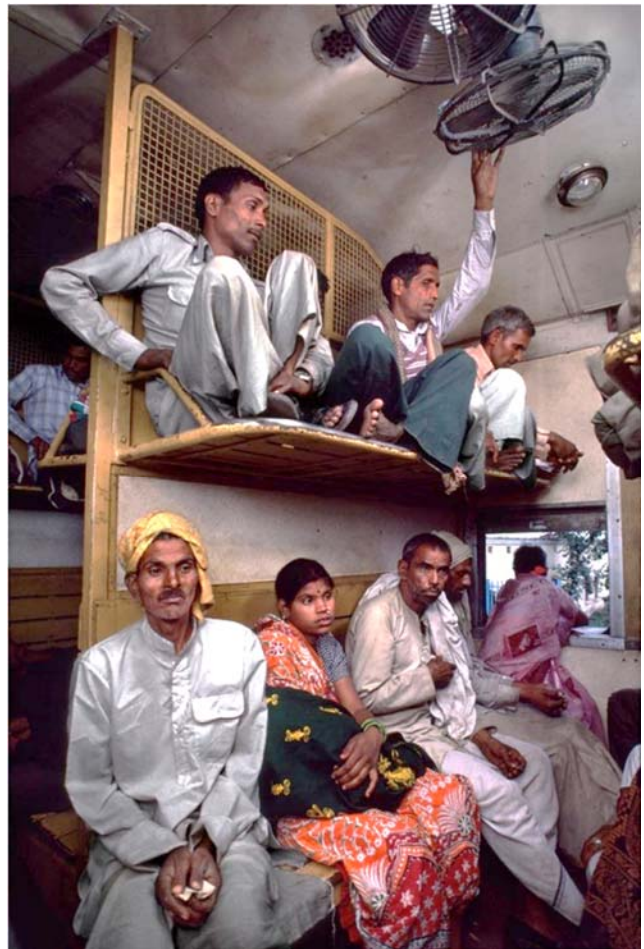
